

Documents needed for filing Income Tax Returns for Indian citizen

Time is now. Don't wait for the last date to file your income tax return (August 31, 2015). Gather these documents to e-file your income tax returns in India.

The documents needed for each individual may vary based on his/her own case.

❖ Form 16

For Salaried Employees

- Form-16 issued by your current employer (& previous employer during the current FY)

❖ Documents related to other income

- Bank Interest/ Interest from Fixed Deposits (Bank statement/passbook)
- Dividend from Equities/ Mutual Funds
- TDS certificates issued by banks and others for deductions made
- Capital Gains (short term & Long term) during the period on shares / securities & other assets.
- Income from property (if rented out)

❖ Investments under Section 80 C

- Proof of investments made during the FY under section 80C. These can include PPF, NSC, ULIPS, ELSS, RGESS Insurance premium paid, Stamp-duty and registration charges, Principal repayment on your home loan

❖ Investments under Section 80 D

- Proof of mediclaim premium paid for self/family to avail exemption under section 80D

❖ Investments under any other section, for which you are eligible

- Proof of investments under any other section for which you are eligible including handicapped, educational loan etc.

❖ Other Investment Documents

- Interest paid on housing loan. Interest on housing loan is eligible for tax saving upto Rs 2,00,000. This is for a self-occupied house.
- Education loan interest payments.
